# Dr. Sirajuddin Aziz

Chairman - Banking Ombudsman of Pakistan

Madam Chancellor, co-speakers of the podium, distinguished guests, excellencies of the diplomatic corps, ladies and gentlemen, boys and girls!

At the outset of I wish to congratulate the graduating students in particular and also students associated with Greenwich University. I have been tasked today to speak to you more particularly to graduating students about the role you are expected to play in the context of your country, Pakistan. The theme for the event tonight has to be the theme of the rest of your life which is “Pakistan”

You can never dissociate yourself from the fundamental of the fact that you belong to this country.

Patriotism is something which is loosely defined as a passion that you have for the country where you are born and for that you need to have a sense of responsibility, a deep and a remarkable sense of belongingness to the place where you are associated with. What is happened is that, if you look at history, patriotism was never considered a civic duty, at least until the 18th century, most of the Europe looked at patriotism as an aberration to the commitment people had to have to the church or to the state. So, it is a concept that developed over a period of time and it ultimately got confused with nationalism.

Now I want you, particularly my young students to have a very clear view of these two concepts. They are not synonymous; they are neither contradictory but they have different connotations altogether. Patriotism is a passion that stems out of your love for your country. It is based on the principles of freedom, equity, liberty and fraternity. While, if you look at nationalism, Nationalism is a contrary subject to it in the sense that



you consider my country, our country to be better than others. The moment you do that you get into an adversarial position. Now you are competing with the rest of the people to prove that you are better. Now in order to be a patriot, my dear boys and girls, you don't have to make mankind your enemy, you can still be friendly with the rest of the world and still be extremely patriotic. So, what does it mean? It means that you are committed to your motherland. Now I have used the word motherland, there are certain countries that do not use the word motherland rather they call it the fatherland like Germany does. Now I invite your attention, ladies and gentlemen, isn't it very lovely really, conceptually speaking that we should call our Pakistan our motherland because what does it do. First and foremost, the honor of the title of a mother is bestowed so we consider our country to be our mother and as soon as you use the word mother, what does it signify? What does it tell us? That a mother gives unconditional, undiluted, unalloyed love to all her children without favor, distinction or fear. So consequently, the country gives you that as against it does not mean that fathers don't love their countries. Its only fathers are supposing to be more serious about business and therefore, the emotional attachment that you develop out of a motherland concept is greater. So, we should be proud of the fact that we refer to our country as motherland. I would also like to tell you that the benefit of remaining committed to your own country is extremely crucial because we live in an interdependent and interconnected world. At the start of the proceedings today, ladies and gentlemen, we all observed a minute of silence for the many martyrs in the Middle East particularly the Gaza strip. I would like to address my young students out here there is a lesson for all of us there and let's be mindful for what the lesson is, that in your struggle you are alone, you are alone, you have to look after yourself. How do you look after yourself? You look after yourself only through the means of economically strengthened nation. If we are weak economically then we are dependent. Let the dependence be of a different nature where there is interaction and inter connectedness between us in the world but in the process, we must strengthen our own economic condition. If we remain dependent on hand outs by international multilateral institutions or by friendly governments then remember as a nation, no matter how greater patriot you maybe but you shall remain weak, weak in your resolve.

In order for us to be standing up with a respite in the comity of nations, it is extremely important that we drive ourselves first in economic strength because that will allow us to have political strength. Also, patriotism is not something that is restricted to the fact that one has to make an announcement of it, one does not have to make a pronouncement of it. A patriot is a given thing, a patriotism is a given thing. No body is less patriotic in this country and nobody is more patriotic in this country. We all are, we all love our country. Let there be no doubt in our minds about that fact because we have referred to a mother and who is here that would dare to say that I do not love my mother. So, let's be very clear about it. All population of Pakistan is a patriotic population that merely needs direction, that's about it. Talent that is available in this country is something that you must utilize for your country. It is extremely easy for politicians to be claiming and pounding their rostrums, saying with their clinched fists that we have a population that is 65% below the age of thirty-five.
