Scholarship Policy

Purpose

To provide a fair and transparent framework for awarding scholarships and financial assistance that promotes academic excellence, supports deserving students, and ensures equal access to quality higher education.

Scope

This Policy applies to all eligible students enrolled at Greenwich University and governs the eligibility, award, renewal, continuation, and administration of all University-funded and externally sponsored scholarships and financial assistance programmes.

N.B: Fee waivers shall apply only to tuition fees. No fee waiver shall be granted on administrative charges, including but not limited to registration fee, examination fee, laboratory fee, library fee, and any other applicable charges.

Scholarship Terms and Conditions

1. Eligibility

A student shall not be entitled to avail more than one scholarship simultaneously. In cases where a student qualifies for multiple scholarships, only one scholarship offering the highest benefit may be availed.

2. Application Requirement

All applicants seeking scholarship benefits must submit a duly completed Scholarship Application Form along with the required supporting documents within the prescribed deadline.



3. Minimum Credit Hour Requirement

Students must maintain a full academic load as prescribed below:

Undergraduate (AS/BS)	15 Credit Hours
Graduate (MS/MBA/M.Phil.)	09 Credit Hours
Doctoral Program (PhD)	06 Credit Hours

4. Circumstances Under Which Scholarships Shall Not Be Awarded or Continued

Scholarships shall not be granted, renewed, or continued in the following cases:

1. During Summer Semester(s).
2. If the student exceeds the prescribed duration of the degree program.
3. If the student takes a semester break, leave of absence, or freezes studies.
4. If the registered credit hours after the Add/Drop period fall below the minimum required course load.
5. If the student receives an F (Fail), W (Withdrawal), I (Incomplete), or Repeat grade in any course during the scholarship period.
6. If the student is found guilty of misconduct, violation of university rules, or any disciplinary offense and is penalized by the University Discipline Committee.
7. Submission of false information, forged documents, or concealment of facts shall result in immediate cancellation of the scholarship and may lead to further disciplinary action.
8. The University reserves the right to review, amend, suspend, or withdraw any scholarship scheme at any time without prior notice.

5. Copy of Declared monthly income of parents/guardians (from all sources) $\leq$ 60K
6. Copy of Bank statement last three months/ Pay slip
7. Copy of Utility bills (last three months)
8. Declared statement of your relationship (Student Sibling, Faculty/Staff & Dependents/Alumni) {if required}



5.. Final Authority

The Scholarship Committee shall review all scholarship applications and recommendations. The decision of the Vice Chancellor/Competent Authority shall be final and binding in all scholarship matters. With effective from Fall 2026.

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Greenwich University reserves the right to amend, revise, suspend, or withdraw this Policy, in whole or in part, at any time without prior notice. Any amendments or revisions approved by the Competent Authority shall supersede all previous versions and shall become effective from the date of approval.
